
COVID-19 Vaccines in Prisons




The Center for Disease Control released <u>guidelines</u> which divided vaccine distribution into three phases. States were then asked to propose plans for distribution based on those phases. The maps below indicates where the vaccination of prisoners and correctional officers have been placed within each state's respective phased rollouts.
